How Much Water Does My Food Garden Need?

How Much Water Does My Food Garden Need? 8 ft 4 ft Bed is 4 x 8 feet or 32 square feet 21 emitters in bed = 1/2 gallon per hour drip emitter on 1 foot center Example: For vegetables in the summer, we recommend applying about 1 inch of water over the surface area of the garden bed per week That is equivalent to 0623 gallons per sq ft
